Course Description:

This course is a **full year**, beginner course in programming. Students will be studying the basics of computer programming. The programming tool we will use is the popular and powerful language called Python (Python.org). Students will be exploring the fundamental logical concepts of programming that apply to any programming language. This course will include the state standards and objectives for Computer Programming I.

College Credit:

There is an option for Juniors and Seniors receiving credit for Dixie State College course CS 1400 (Fundamentals of Programming). Students must register at the beginning of the course to be eligible.

Things you will need:

- 1. **Notebook** for just this class. You will be expected to take notes.
- 2. **Headphones** (¼ jack, or usb) for sound on the computers.

Grades:

Grades will be a percentage of time spent learning compared to the amount of time available in the classroom. Attendance is critical. Assignments will be recorded to document understanding of topics. Full participation is mandatory.

Making up Time: If you miss time in the classroom or choose not to participate for any reason--excused or not--you can make up the time by studying the class-work at home.

- 1. Record your **time spent** studying at home and
- 2. Write a page of what you learned (hand written), then
- 3. Have your **parent/guardian sign** the paper and approve your work.
