Course Description:

This is a beginner course in digital media. Students will be studying many industry standard media tools and basic principles and elements of design. Students will practice basic video editing skills using iMovie. They will practice Photoshop, Illustrator, etc. They will create a professional portfolio of their creations. This course will include the state standards and objectives for Digital Media I.

Things you will need:

- 1. **Notebook** for just this class. We will be writing in a daily journal.
- 2. **Headphones** (¼ jack, or usb) for sound on the computers.

Grades:

Grades will be a percentage of time spent learning compared to the amount of time available in the classroom. Attendance is critical. Assignments will be recorded to document understanding of topics. Full participation is mandatory.
